



Attend the Senior Meeting with your Counselor

Your counselor will walk you through the steps to apply to college. Be sure to come with any questions you may have.

Do you need a Counselor Recommendation?

Maybe. Many colleges prefer to hear from your teacher, but some may also want to hear from your school counselor. If you decide you need a counselor recommendation, please follow the steps below

Step 1: Fill out the [Teacher Comment Form](#).

First talk to 3 teacher that you have a good relationship with. Ask them if they will provide comments for you. Then fill out the form.

Step 2: [Student Self Assessment](#)

This step asks you to reflect on your strengths and growth areas. It also gives important information about your aspirations that we can highlight in your letter

Step 3: [Parent/Guardian Assessment](#)

Adults in our lives often say the best things about us. Give this link to your parent or guardian so that they can also reflect on your strengths.

Step 4: [Request your Transcript and a Letter of](#)

This form officially requests a Counselor letter of recommendation to be sent to your college or university. This is also where you request your transcript to be sent.
